NOTICE Intention to Designate a Property / Ontario Heritage Act

The Council of the City of Markham intends to designate the following property for reasons of cultural heritage value or interest pursuant to the *Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990*, Chapter O.18, Part IV:

Thomas and Catharine Peach House 10387 McCowan Road Markham, ON

The Thomas and Catharine Peach House has design and physical value as a fine representative example of a farmhouse in the Georgian architectural tradition with the influence of the Neoclassical style. The Thomas and Catharine Peach House has historical and associative value, representing the theme of immigration, particularly the significant wave of British families who came to Markham Township from 1830 onwards, and the theme of the improvement of nineteenth century farmsteads as the agricultural community progressed past the early settlement phase. Further, the dwelling has contextual value as one of several important mid-nineteenth century farmhouses on the stretch of McCowan Road between Major Mackenzie Drive and Elgin Mills Road. Together these high-quality, substantial farm residences are an indication of the prosperity of Markham Township's agricultural community in the mid-nineteenth century.
