The Council of the City of Markham intends to designate the following property for reasons of cultural heritage value or interest pursuant to the *Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990*, Chapter O.18, Part IV:

Box Grove United Church 2 Legacy Drive Markham, ON

The Box Grove United Church has design and physical value as a representative example of a late-nineteenth century vernacular, frame village church designed with the influences of the Classic Revival and Italianate architectural styles. The Box Grove United Church has historical and associative value, representing the theme of religious and cultural diversity within early Markham to which it is linked as a location of consistent Christian worship for over 190 years. Further, the church has contextual value as a key heritage building in a grouping of nineteenth century buildings that are important in defining, maintaining and supporting the character of the historic hamlet of Box Grove.
