

10.0 Summary of Public Input

Through the various methods of public input, a number of responses and comments were received. The entire record of public comments and submissions are available from Town staff by request.

The following list summarizes the key input received through the online and brochure survey, from comment sheets received at public open houses, and from conversations with members of the public who attended the public open houses.

- Strength of the existing facilities such as Toogood Pond, Milne Park and the Rouge River
- A lack of connectivity between the existing pathways and trails
- Implementation is not being done fast enough
- Users want to be able to walk / cycle to destinations avoiding busy roads
- Pathways and trails are a viable mode of active transportation. They are not only a recreational / leisure amenity.
