Intention to Designate a Property / Ontario Heritage Act

The Council of the City of Markham intends to designate the following property for reasons of cultural heritage value or interest pursuant to the *Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990*, Chapter O.18, Part IV:

Rolph Boynton House
10732 Victoria Square Blvd
Markham, ON

The Rolph Boynton House has design and physical value as a representative example of an early twentieth century Craftsman-style village dwelling. The Rolph Boynton House has historical value and associative value as it makes legible the development of the hamlet of Victoria Square in the early twentieth century, and specifically the creation of retirement properties in village settings for former local farmers. Further, the property has contextual value as one of a grouping of late nineteenth and early twentieth century buildings that are important in defining, maintaining and supporting the character and extent of the historic hamlet of Victoria Square.

Any person may notify the City of Markham of their objection in writing, which shall include the reasons for their objection and all relevant facts, **on or before 4:30 p.m. July 2, 2024** to be sent by registered mail or dropped off in person to:
