



Inclusive Markham

- \$4.5M Active Transportation Master Plan Construction and programs, including Active School Travel Program, Smart Commute, and Markham Cycles
- \$1.5M Upgrades and accessibility improvements in parks and playgrounds to meet AODA requirements
- The City and Destination Markham Corporation has secured a 3-year hosting agreement with the Little Native Hockey League (LNHL) from 2025 to 2027




Lowest 20-Year Average Tax Rate Increase in the GTA








