Frisby House 15 Victoria Street Markham. ON

The Frisby House has design and physical value as a representative example of a village dwelling in the Ontario Classic style. The Frisby House has historical and associative value representing the theme of urban development, specifically the nineteenth century development of the crossroads hamlet of Victoria Square, originally named Read's Corners. Further, the property has contextual value as one of a grouping of older buildings that are important in defining, maintaining and supporting the character and extent of the historic hamlet of Victoria Square, and for being historically linked to the Thomas Frisby Jr. House at 83 Thomas Frisby Jr. Crescent.
