

NOTICE
Intention to Designate a Property / Ontario Heritage Act

The Council of the City of Markham intends to designate the following property for reasons of cultural heritage value or interest pursuant to the *Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990*, Chapter O.18, Part IV:

Grove Cottage
6084 Nineteenth Avenue
Markham, ON

Grove Cottage had design and physical value as a representative, but late example of a Craftsman bungalow in the American Arts and Crafts Movement tradition. Grove Cottage has historical and associative value, making legible the early twentieth century growth of Dickson Hill, and more specifically the trend whereby building lots were severed from local farms to expand the footprint of the hamlet. Further, the property has contextual value as one of a number of nineteenth and early twentieth century buildings that define the character and extent of the historic hamlet of Dickson Hill.
