NOTICE Intention to Designate a Property / Ontario Heritage Act

The Council of the City of Markham intends to designate the following property for reasons of cultural heritage value or interest pursuant to the *Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990*, Chapter O.18, Part IV:

Box Grove General Store 6772 Fourteenth Avenue Markham, ON

The Box Grove General Store has design and physical value as a representative example of a combined village store and residence constructed in the mid-nineteenth century. It is a vernacular building of a type that was once common in the villages of Markham Township – a combined store and residence that allowed the proprietor to live adjacent to the workplace. The Box Grove General Store has historical and associative value, representing the theme of industry, innovation and economic development as the general store that served the Box Grove community from the early 1860s until the mid-twentieth century. It also has historical and associative value at it was as the location of the Box Grove post office from 1867 to 1918. Further, the Box Grove General Store has contextual value as a key heritage building in a grouping of nineteenth century buildings that are important in defining, maintaining and supporting the character of the historic hamlet of Box Grove.
