
## **HOW TO READ YOUR WATER METER**



The City of Markham will read your meter for billing purposes, but should you wish to monitor your own consumption, here's how:

- Continually shine a flashlight over the solar panel (located on the register) to activate the LCD display \*
- Take a reading at a set time of the day
- ◆ Take a 2<sup>nd</sup> reading at the same time the next day
- The difference between the two readings is your daily water consumption
  - Note: when the register display is first activated via a flashlight, all icons will be briefly displayed followed by firmware information. The register display will then toggle (every 4 seconds) displaying the reading and then the flow rate. The flow rate is per minute. When the display indicates "RATE", the flow rate is being displayed.



The 9 digit LCD displays your meter reading in cubic metres
The last 4 digits of the reading are decimal points.

(e.g. – 26.3987 cubic metres)

(decimal will be displayed)

## Flow Indicator

- displays direction of water flow
- ON- water in use
- ◆ OFF water not in use
- (-) indicates reverse flow
- (+) indicates forward flow
