The Council of the City of Markham intends to designate the following property for reasons of cultural heritage value or interest pursuant to the *Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990*, Chapter O.18, Part IV:

William Henry Meyer House 10690 McCowan Road Markham, ON

The William Henry Meyer House has design and physical value as a representative example of a late-nineteenth century Gothic Revival farmhouse. The William Henry Meyer House has historical and associative value, representing the formerly dominant agricultural character of Markham Township, specifically the improvement of nineteenth century farmsteads as the agricultural community progressed past the early settlement phase. Further, the property has contextual value as a former farmhouse that has stood on its site, east of the historic crossroads hamlet of Cashel, since the early 1890s. As such, it helps make legible the agricultural tradition of Markham Township.
