NOTICE Intention to Designate a Property / Ontario Heritage Act

The Council of the City of Markham intends to designate the following property for reasons of cultural heritage value or interest pursuant to the *Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990*, Chapter O.18, Part IV:

The Milton and Ann Kester House 11584 York-Durham Line Markham, ON

The Milton and Ann Kester House has design and physical value as a locally rare example of a vernacular, patterned brick farmhouse of the Confederation period designed with elements of the Gothic Revival and Italianate architectural styles. The Milton and Ann Kester House has historical and associative value, representing the religious and cultural mosaic theme of Pennsylvania Germans being attracted to Markham Township in the early nineteenth century, and representing the theme of improvement of nineteenth century farmsteads as the agricultural community progressed past the early settlement phase. Further, the property has contextual value as one of a number of nineteenth century farmhouses located in the general vicinity of the historic communities of Mongolia and Stouffville.
