The John and Elizabeth Rowbotham House has design and physical value as a representative example of a vernacular, village tradesman's dwelling of the last quarter of the nineteenth century. The John and Elizabeth Rowbotham House has historical and associative value, representing the theme of nineteenth century development within the hamlet of Victoria Square, and the theme of industry, innovation and economic development as the former residence of John and Elizabeth Rowbotham. Further, the property has contextual value as one of a number of nineteenth and early twentieth century buildings that are important in defining, maintaining and supporting the character and extent of the historic crossroads hamlet of Victoria Square.
