SUBJECT: Senior Management Endorsement of Markham's Corporate Energy Management Plan


In 2011 Markham Council approved the Greenprint, Markham Community Sustainability Plan with the goal of net zero energy, water, waste and emissions by 2050.

To achieve net zero energy by 2050 large reductions in energy consumed in Markham are needed with the significant investment to increase the amount of energy produced in Markham are needed to balance local energy consumption with local energy production on an annual basis.

To support this goal the City has shown leadership in conservation by continuing to make significant investments in facility retrofits to improve our sustainability while reducing operating costs. We are also a leader in renewable energy with 1.4MW of roof top solar on our facilities.

The City of Markham's Corporate Energy Management Plan is a five year plan that is compliant with Province of and Ontario's Green Energy Act, O. Reg. 397/11 by establishing; our current energy consumption and production, setting goals and objectives for conservation and demand management and new construction/major renovation energy efficiency and renewable energy.


