

## STUDENT LIVING FIRE SAFETY CHECK LIST ✓

When away at school, stay cool & make sure that your new home is fire safe!

ASK THE LANDLORD	✓
Smoke alarm present on every floor	
Carbon monoxide (CO) detector present on floors with a bedroom	
Smoke alarm batteries replaced every six months	
Smoke alarm & CO detectors tested once a month	
Smoke alarms are not more than 10 years old	
Windows & security bars are opened easily	_

ASK ROOMMATES	✓
Meeting place established outside in case of a fire	
Burning candles are never left unattended	
Cooking is never left unattended	
No smoking permitted indoors	
Dryer lint trap is cleaned regularly	
Heat sources are kept clear of combustible material	

ASK YOURSELF	✓
Smoke alarm & CO detector can be heard from bedroom	
Two exits are available from bedroom	
Path to exits are clear of obstructions	
Extension cords are not in permanent use	
Electrical outlets are not overloaded	
Wires/electrical cords are not under carpets/rugs
