NOTICE OF PASSING OF DEVELOPMENT CHARGE BY-LAWS

DEVELOPMENT CHARGES ACT, 1997, S.O. 1997, c.27

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the City of Markham passed By-laws Nos. 2022-49 to 2022-72, inclusive, on May 31st, 2022 pursuant to Section 2 of the Development Charges Act, 1997, S.O. 1997, c.27. The aforementioned by-laws will come into force and effect on June 17th, 2022.

The aforementioned by-laws include two City-wide by-laws:

- **By-law 2022-49** which establishes development charges for hard services, which are the roads and related infrastructure, storm water management, water, wastewater and engineering studies development charges, and
- **By-law 2022-50** which establishes the development charges for soft services, which are library, fire, indoor recreation, parks, public works, waste management and general services development charges.

These City-wide by-laws set development charge rates for residential and non-residential development for the services described above, on a municipal-wide basis.

The development charges established through By-laws 2022-49 and 2022-50 are calculated on a "per unit" basis for residential development and on a "square metre" basis for non-residential development. The development charges under by-laws 2022-49 and 2022-50 are set out below:

By-laws 2022-51 to 2022-72 inclusive, are area specific by-laws which establish development charges for certain areas of the municipality, and are applicable only with

respect to development occurring within those areas. The area-specific by-laws set rates to recover the cost of the sanitary sewers, storm water management, roads and related infrastructure, and water main development within those areas. Set out below are the applicable residential and non-residential charges imposed under by-laws 2022-51 to 2022-72, with reference to the by-law number, the area number (which corresponds to a key map), the area name, and the charge per net development hectare:
