Take notice that on Tuesday, April 12th 2022, the Council of the City of Markham will hold a public meeting pursuant to:

- *The Development Charges Act, 1997*, regarding proposed development charge rates and policies that will be applied throughout the City.
- *The Planning Act*, regarding the proposed community benefits charge that will be applied to select developments throughout the City of Markham

It is proposed that enactment of the Development Charges By-laws and, Community Benefits Charges By-law by Council, would occur on a date subsequent to the public meeting.

Development charges are levied against new development, and are a primary source of funding for development-related capital expenditures. The 2022 Development Charges Study relates to the provision of City Wide Soft, City Wide Hard and Area Specific Services for the municipality.

Community Benefits Charges is a new source of funding for growth-related capital expenditures enacted under the *Planning Act* and, is to be levied against developments with 5 or more storeys and 10 or more residential units.

Council is required under *The Development Charges Act, 1997*, to hold at least one public meeting to allow the public the opportunity to review and provide comments on the 2022 Development Charges Study, related staff reports/presentations and the proposed new development charges by-law.

With respect to the Community Benefits Charge Strategy, the Planning Act requires the municipality to consult with such persons and public bodies as the municipalities considers appropriate. This public meeting provides the public opportunity to comment on the Community Benefits Strategy and proposed by-law, both of which will be available on the City's website in advance of the public meeting

5.1 DEVELOPMENT CHARGES BACKGROUND STUDY & COMMUNITY BENEFITS CHARGES STRATEGY - STATUTORY PUBLIC MEETING

Kevin Ross, Manager, Development Finance and Payroll, addressed the Committee and indicated that today's statutory meeting will provide information on the Development Charges (DC) Background Study and Community Benefit Charges (CBC) Strategy in relation to DC and CBC rates, their respective policies and identify key milestones. He further indicated that this process is to further promote the engagement of public and industry consultation. Mr. Ross introduced Craig Binning, Partner, Hemson Consulting.
