Notice of Public Meeting Markham's new Official Plan

In accordance with Sections 17 and 26 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended)

You are invited to attend a Public Meeting to learn about and provide comments on Markham's new Draft Official Plan. The Draft Official Plan sets out where and how our City will grow over the next 20 years.

DATE: Tuesday, November 6, 2012 TIME: Open House 6 to 7 pm Public Meeting 7 pm

An Open House will be held from 6 to 7 pm prior to the Public Meeting. Markham staff will be available at the Open House to answer questions on the Draft Official Plan. The Open House portion of the evening is an information session only and does not constitute part of the statutory Public Meeting on November 6, 2012.

Note: In addition to this Public Meeting, a series of Community Open Houses will be held in November and December 2012, followed by a second Public Meeting in early 2013. Separate notices will be issued for these meetings, once dates have been confirmed.

Why has a new Official Plan been prepared?

The Official Plan is a statutory document that sets out land use policy to guide growth, land use planning and development approvals in Markham. The Planning Act requires that municipalities review their Official Plans at least every 5 years. The City initiated an Official Plan Review program in 2011. The new Draft Official Plan implements recent provincial policies and plans such as the Greenbelt Plan and the Growth Plan for the Greater Golden Horseshoe, and the York Region Official Plan. It also implements a Councilendorsed strategy for accommodating population and employment growth to 2031 that directs most of the growth to identified centres along proposed rapid transit routes, and allows for limited expansion of the urban area. The Plan provides a vision for growth in Markham based on the principles of protecting natural environment and agricultural lands, building healthy communities, increasing travel options and maintaining a strong economy.

Markham's new Official Plan is comprised of three parts: Part 1 – Official Plan; Part 2 – Secondary Plans; and Part 3 – Site Specific Policies. Part 1, which contains policies that apply City-wide, has been released for review and comment. Parts 2 and 3, which will contain area-specific and site-specific policies, will be released at a later date. The Official Plan policies under review apply to the entire municipality of Markham, and therefore a key map is not provided with this notice. No decisions will be made on the new Draft Official Plan at the Public Meeting.

Please take notice that

If you disagree with a decision of Council, you have the right to appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board (OMB). However, the OMB can dismiss all or part of your appeal if you do not participate in the consultation process and provide your comments to Council.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a Public Meeting or make written submissions to the Council of the City of Markham before the proposed Official Plan is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal a decision of The Regional Municipality of York (the approval authority) to the Ontario Municipal Board.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a Public Meeting or make written submissions to the Council of the City of Markham before the proposed Official Plan is adopted, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

Personal Information Collection Notice

The names of persons providing submissions, and all submissions may become part of a public record, and may be used by the City of Markham for future notification as part of the Official Plan Review process.
