Intention to Designate a Property / Ontario Heritage Act

The Council of the City of Markham intends to designate the following property for reasons of cultural heritage value or interest pursuant to the *Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter O.18, Part IV*:

Peach's United Church
10762 McCowan Road
Markham, ON

Peach's United Church has design and physical value as a late representative example of a rural chapel in the vernacular Early Gothic Revival architectural style. Peach's United Church, founded in 1847 as a Primitive Methodist church, has historical value as it is representative of the early diversity of Christianity within Markham Township. Further, the property has contextual value for being physically, functionally, visually and historically linked to its site, where it has stood since 1863. It has further contextual value for being historically linked to the John Peach House at 5060 Elgin Mills Road East, and as a landmark at the north-west corner of Elgin Mills Road East and McCowan Road.

Any person may notify the City of Markham of their objection in writing, which shall include the reasons for their objection and all relevant facts, **on or before 4:30 p.m. April 8, 2024** to be sent by registered mail or dropped off in person to:
