> The John and Elizabeth Hilts House has design and physical value as representative example of a vernacular village dwelling in a late rendition of the Georgian architectural style. The John and Elizabeth Hilts House has historical value as it makes legible the early development of the hamlet of Victoria Square, specifically the creation of retirement properties in village settings for retired local farmers. The property also has associative value for its connection to the locally-significant Pennsylvania German Tunkard community within Markham Township. Further, the property has contextual value as one of a number of nineteenth and early twentieth century buildings are important in defining, maintaining and supporting the character and extent of the historic hamlet of Victoria Square.
