
Terms and Conditions – Retroactive Installation Application

- In these Terms & Conditions
 - (a) "Retroactive Installation" means a Private Plumbing Protection Measure implemented between May 1, 2017 and May 1, 2018;
 - (b) "Property Owner" means the registered owner of the property in the City of Markham
 - (c) "Program" means Pilot Private Plumbing Protection Program defined in By-law 2018-20;
 - (d) "City" means the Corporation of the City of Markham and shall include, from time to time, any officer, council member, employee or agent of the City who has been authorized to act on the City's behalf;
 - (e) "Work" means the implementation of Private Plumbing Protection Measures:
 - (i) Installation of backwater valve on sanitary or storm lateral
 - (ii) Weeping tile/foundation drain disconnection and sump pump installation
 - (iii) Sanitary/storm lateral relining/repair
- Information collected on this form will be used to assist City staff in making a decision on this application for rebate. Questions regarding this collection should be forwarded to the City Clerk. The completion of this form constitutes consent by the applicant to the collection, use, disclosure, storage, and destruction of the information contained herein by the City for the purpose for which it was collected pursuant to the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.
- A Property Owner will be entitle to receive a rebate if they meet all of the following requirements
 - (a) The Property must be serviced by City sewers.
 - (b) The Property is not the subject of any contraventions, work orders or outstanding municipal requirements;
 - (c) There are no outstanding municipal fines, arrears of taxes, fees or penalties assessed against the Property Owner; (d) The completed work has been inspected and verified by the City's consultant and/or staff
- The City may grant rebates for each Private Plumbing Protection Measure up to the following maximum amounts, for eligible costs only:

Backwater Valve – Indoor Installed on Storm Lateral	\$1,750		
Backwater Valve – Outdoor Installed on Storm Lateral	\$2,000		
Weeping Tile Disconnection and Redirect to Storm Lateral	\$3,000		
Weeping Tile Disconnection and Sump Pump Installation	\$5,000		
Lateral Reline/Repair – Storm	\$2,500		
Lateral Reline/Repair – Sanitary	\$2,500		

- Eligible cost including:
 - (a) Material and labour costs for the implementation of the Private Plumbing Protection Measure:

 - (c) Consulting or inspection costs to determine appropriate Private Plumbing Protection Measures to be implemented on the Property, and
 - (d) Cost of downspout disconnection prior to the installation of backwater valve or sump pump.
- The rebate shall not cover reimbursement for the following:
 - (a) Replacement of any interior finishes including drywall, painting or flooring, required to undertaken as a result of the completion of the
 - (b) Exterior restoration including landscaping, gardens, shrubs, trees, porches, decks, required or undertaken as a result of the completion of the work.
 - (c) Any labour undertaken by the Property Owner
- Completed Work is defined as Work that is fully functional and acceptable as per Ontario Building Code Standards, and any City or other industry standards that may apply. Work is only deemed "Complete" upon meeting applicable standards and approval by the City Building Inspector. The City may inspect work at any time for completeness.
- Before a backwater valve installed on sanitary sewer, all the downspouts have to be disconnected from the sewer system and weeping 8. tile/foundation drain is not connected or has to be disconnected to the sanitary sewer.
- A backwater valve can only be installed on the main service line of the property when it is a one dwelling unit. When there are multiple dwelling units on the property, a backwater valve has to be installed on branch line servicing each unit.
- 10. All Work, and inspection of Work, is to be coordinated by the property owner. The property owner is responsible for the on-going operation, maintenance and future replacement of all equipment installed as part of the Work.
- 11. The property owner must sign the City's application form and waiver form, releasing the City of Markham from any liability resulting from Work carried out as part of the Private Plumbing Protection Rebate Program.
- 12. Reimbursement will occur upon satisfactory review of the submitted required forms and associated documentation, and the Work being declared Complete accompanied with a copy of the detailed work invoice paid. A Cheque will be mailed out within 4-6 weeks of receipt of an acceptable and complete application.
- 13. The City reserves the right to accept or reject, at its sole discretion, any application or any part thereof.
- 14. At any time and for any reason, the City may terminate the Program and refuse any or all further applications. Any such decisions may be made at the City's sole discretion.
- 15. Failure to meet any or all conditions of the Terms and Conditions may result in application refusal, disentitlement to any subsidy, and/or refusal of future applications to the Program.
- 16. The Private Plumbing Protection Rebate is a one-time rebate.

WAIVER AND RELEASE TERMS AND CONDITIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- 1) I/We hereby certify that I am/we are the owner(s) of the above-referenced Property.
- 2) I/We, the Property Owner(s), exercising sole discretion, have allowed a contractor selected by me/us to implement Private Plumbing Protection Measures (the **Work**) on the Property's private plumbing systems.
- 3) The Work may include any of the following types of measures at the Property and may qualify me/us for a rebate based on compliance with the terms of the City's Pilot Private Plumbing Protection Program (the **Program**):
 - (a) Installation of backwater valve on sanitary or/and storm laterals (indoor or outdoor)
 - (b) Disconnection of weeping tile and installation of sump pump
 - (c) Lateral relining/repair
- 3) In consideration for our participation in the Program, I/we the Property Owner(s) understand, acknowledge, and agree as follows:
 - (a) The City's rebate for completed Work as part of the Program is not in any way deemed, construed, interpreted or implied to be an admission on the part of the City, its councillors, officers, employees or agents of any liability or responsibility whatsoever for past or future flooding or any other events, whatsoever and howsoever caused, that impact the Property, and which have or may occur in the public or private wastewater and storm water systems;
 - (b) The means and methods utilized in the performance of the Work by the Property Owner's selected contractor are not controlled, induced or reviewed by the City. The City does not provide any warranty or guarantee in respect of the suitability, operation, or acceptance of the completed Work at the Property;

- c) The City makes no further representations or warranties regarding the Work, including any fitness for a particular purpose;
- (d) I/We (for myself/ourselves, my/our heirs, executors, administrators, successors, assigns and invitees) WAIVE, RELEASE, AND FOREVER DISCHARGE the City, and its affiliates, elected officials, directors, officers, employees and agents (collectively the "Indemnitees") from any and all demands, claims, actions, or proceeding of any kind it may have related to any damage, harm, losses, or injuries which may result from the Work unless caused by the negligence of the City;
- (e) I/We acknowledge and agree that the wastewater and storm water systems located on the Property are my/our responsibility, including all future maintenance and upkeep. The performance of the Work in no way deems anything located on the Property now or in the future as being part of the City of Markham's wastewater or stormwater system. I/We hereby agree to HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY the Indemnitees from all claims, demands, damages, costs, expenses, actions and causes of action, whether in law or in equity, which they might sustain or incur, arising as a result of, or in any way connected with my/our failure to maintain or repair the Work
- (f) In the event of a sale or lease of the Property, I/we agree to inform the purchaser or lessee of the Property of the completed Work and any applicable maintenance requirements.
- 4) I/We agree that this waiver shall be considered validly executed and delivered if sent by fax or in a .pdf (or other common electronic format) by e-mail. Such facsimile or e- mail copy shall be deemed to have the same force and effect as an executed original.
- 5) I/We declare that the Property is not the subject of any contraventions, work orders or outstanding municipal requirements and there are no outstanding municipal fines, arrears of taxes, fees or penalties assessed against me/us.
- 6) By signing below, I/we warrant that I/we have legal capacity to execute this waiver, and acknowledge I/we have read, understand, and agree to the terms and conditions set out above. I/we further acknowledge that I/we have not been induced to execute this wavier, and I/we have had the opportunity to obtain independent legal advice prior to signing this document.
