

Distance: 12.1km | Cycling Time: 1 hour | Walk Time: 2.5 hours

This new active transportation loop connects Main Street Unionville to Main Street Markham, making it easier and safer for cyclists and pedestrians to get to these popular and iconic village hubs through part of the Rouge Valley Trail system, Carlton Road and Raymer Drive.

Both Main Streets are also linked to more trails of the Rouge Valley Trail System, effectively allowing you to travel across the old Villages of Markham and Unionville while enjoying the beautiful scenery and neighbourhoods of our city.

Route Design:

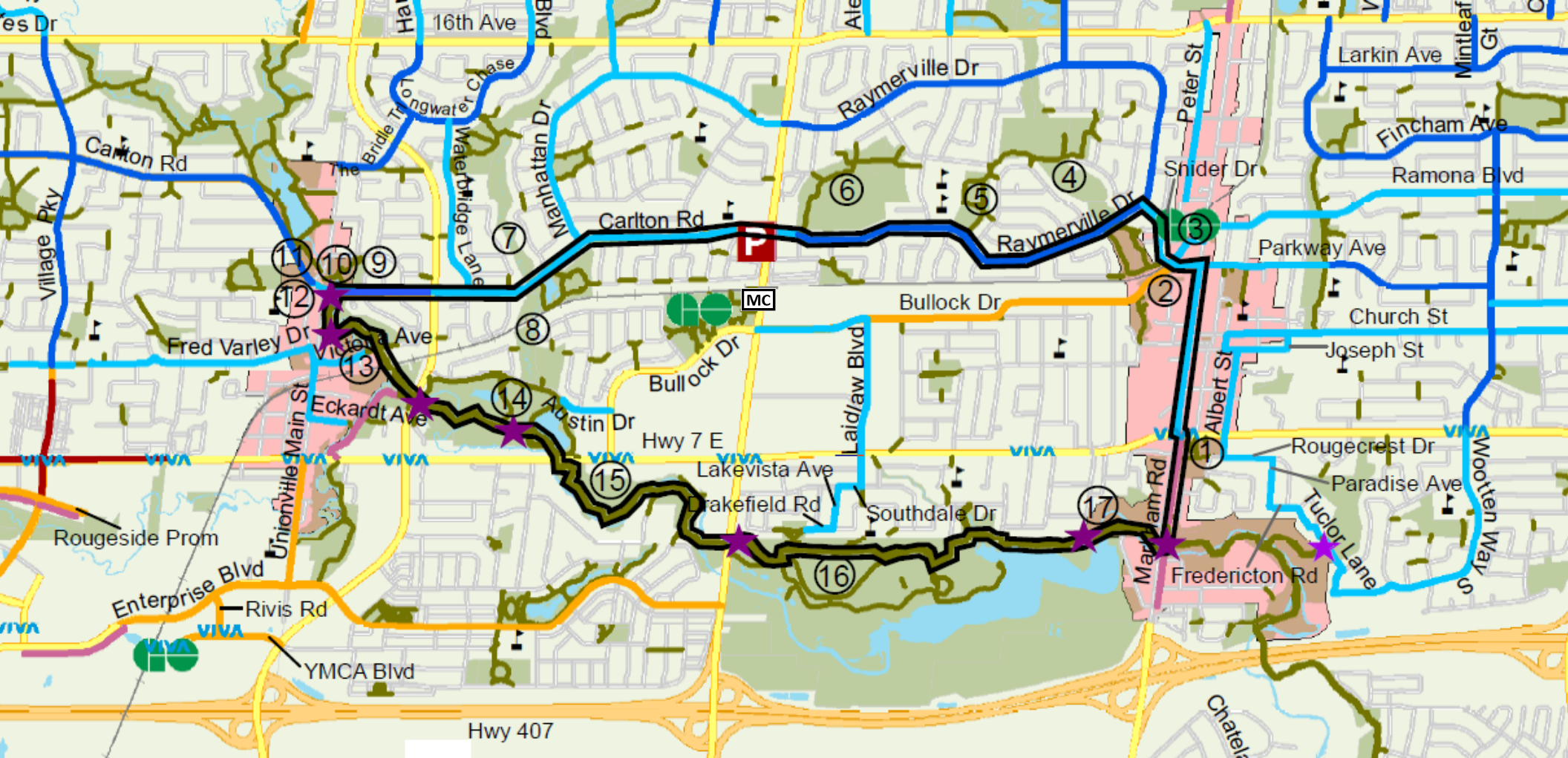
- Riding Difficulty: EASY
