

How to become a Lifeguard and Swim Instructor in Markham!

National Lifeguard

Prerequisites: Bronze Cross, Standard First Aid and 15 years of age.

Airway Management

Provides lifeguards and swim instructors with specific knowledge and training in the use of
oxygen, suction devices, oral airways and bag-valve-masks (BVM).
Prerequisite: Standard First Aid.

Once you successfully complete Airway Management and Instructors: Swim and Lifesaving and/or National Lifeguard and are 16 years of age, you can become a Lifeguard and Swim Instructor!
